Dear Todd,

Time to walk away from Adani

We are writing to insist that you end AECOM's business relationship with Adani immediately. You will know through media reports that our citizen action groups forced Downer EDI to end their business relationship with Adani through disruptive nonviolent direct action, shareholder activism and the potential loss of government contracts. AECOM will be next.

AECOM are playing both sides of the fence, working with governments on climate change mitigation while also helping Australia's largest coal mine. Many governments will not appreciate this hypocrisy. We will convince them to engage different companies truly committed to preventing catastrophic climate change.

We will expose your hypocritical relationship with Adani, emphasising what the proposed Carmichael mine will mean for the climate, the Great Barrier Reef, the Great Artesian Basin and Aboriginal homelands. What impact will this have on AECOM's reputation, including your ability to attract and retain staff?

Climate change is the fight of this generation, with governments and corporations such as yours failing us. Thousands of every-day Australians are embracing civil resistance for the very first time, willing to face prosecution that may result.

Australians stood strong to protect the Daintree Rainforest, Fraser Island and Franklin River. They will stand together to protect Aboriginal homelands, the Great Barrier Reef, the Great Artesian Basin and a liveable planet for their children and grandchildren.

Nonviolent direct actions targeting AECOM are being planned in multiple locations, escalating over time. Community members will also be engaging with your recruitment processes, employees, contractors, clients and business partners throughout the country. We will explain our reasons for action, and invite them to voice their disapproval of AECOM's relationship with Adani.

Actions are starting soon. However, we have left enough time for you to withdraw from your business relationship with Adani. We expect this by March 19 through an announcement to Australian media.
